



# Guide for Car-drivers

This is how you find the way from Fornost Erain (Stockholm) to Obel Duinedain (Älvkarleby) by car:

- Drive north on road E4 for 136 km (measured from Norrtull), until a large Chinese building rises out of the woods. It is a hotel called Dragon Gate.
- Take right before the hotel, and continue in a crescent about it that leads to road 291.

- Turn right into road 291, and follow it for 10 km, until a signpost "Älvkarlebyfallen" points to the left.
- Take the road towards Älvkarlebyfallen and follow it through some bends, until it crosses river Dalälven on Karl XIII's bridge and passes the Tourist Hotel's main building, on the left after the bridge.



- Directly after the Tourist Hotel a road to the left leads across a bridge (the Bifrost bridge) to Tol Cablim (Laxön island).

- The jubilee reception is in a small conference house in the middle of the island. Before you reach it there is a car park at Sennas (the hostel). There is a larger one a bit further away at Aestam (our dining hall, Restaurant Laxön).

The musical *Battle* is performed in the Rio theatre in the Folkets Hus building in Skutskär. We go there in rented coaches. If you prefer to drive there in your car, tell the jubilee chief, Earl Beregond, beforehand. Drive like this:

- Go from Tol Cablim across the Bifrost bridge and turn left.
- The road is called Uppsalavägen, and after a bend to the right it merges into Västanåvägen.
- Follow Västanåvägen for 5 km, until it ends reaching road 76, called Gävlevägen.
- Turn left into Gävlevägen and follow it for 3 km. The Folkets Hus building in Skutskär is on Gävlevägen 24.



This is how to drive from Tol Cablim to Echad (the lodge camp):

- Go from Tol Cablim across the Bifrost bridge and turn right.
- Follow road signs towards "Älvkarleby Fiskecamp".
